## PRINCIPAL REV. DR. VAZHAN ARASU PRESENTED THE ANNUAL REPORT 2015-16

Sixty-five years of glorious history of St. Aloysius' College has been remarkable and the college has contributed remarkably to transformation of its stakeholders, society and nation at large. The long journey undertaken since 1951 has been eventful and I must congratulate and thank each and everyone involved in this adventurous journey in pursuit of excellence.

This year too like other years witnessed many achievements in curricular, co-curricular and extension activities that brought recognition to the College in diverse realms of endeavours.

The College is at the forefront in the realm of research and publication. This year 83 research articles and papers were published in reputed National and International Journals, 24 chapters were published in books, 07 books published by the college teachers. Volumes of "Journal of Multidisciplinary Research Studies (JMRS)" a peer-reviewed journal and NINAD, research journal were published on time. Six Minor and one Major research projects are ongoing. Faculty members attended 18 International Conferences, 125 National Seminars and 77 National Workshops.

The College had organized two day Workshop on "Human Value and Development Programme" on 16th and 17th June, 2016 for teachers in collaboration with All India Association for Christian Higher Education, New Delhi (AIACHE). The Department of Commerce successfully organized a UGC sponsored two day National Seminar on "Make in India: A Key for Economic Growth in India" on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> March 2016. There were four Technical Sessions and 170 papers were presented in the Seminar.

I must acknowledge the hard work and tireless efforts of students in passing their semester examination. The total number of students who appeared for VI Semester was 1040, out of which 985 students passed, 50 had ATKT and 5 failed. The total percentage of result was 94.71%. The total number of students who appeared in PG was 141, 135 students passed, 04 obtained ATKT and 02 failed. The total percentage of result was 95.74%.

The Aloysians have participated in 22 various cultural activities at the intercollegiate level, in which in six events they secured first position, four events they secured second and in three events they secured third position. The One Act Play was placed first in the Inter Collegiate, Inter- District and Inter University State and qualified for Central Zonal level. In Quiz the college team, secured first position in Inter University and Central Zonal level. The Western Group song and solo classical secured second position at Inter University State Level. In Western Solo Song we secured first position in Inter University State and Central Zonal level. Three of our students namely Tripti Moses, Divyansh Rai and Tanmay Agrawal qualified for National level Youth Festival held at Mysore and Tripti Moses secured third position at the National level.

In keeping with the legacy of Aloysians in sports, the students continued shining and soaring high. This year 08 students participated at the national, 43 at the state, 58 at the district and University and 10 at the All India University level. The college was winner at the intercollegiate level in Table Tennis (Men & Women), Badminton (Men & Women), Basketball (Men & Women), Cricket and Football (Men). The College was Runner-up in Kabbadi (Men & Women), Chess (Men & Women), and Volleyball (Men). I would especially like to congratulate Kapil Kesharwani who participated in Open National Handball and Shakshi Pandey who attended India Camp in Basketball.

The College holds a record in NCC for both boys and girls wings. It's a matter of pride to have such hard working students who have brought recognition to the College at International and National Levels. This year the Union Defence Minister Commendation was received by Senior Cadet Captain S.M. Shahid Shaikh at New Delhi for being the most active cadet. Cadet Sharanya Khamparia received the Chief Minister Commendation and the Defence Secretary Commendation Award at Bhopal along with a cash prize of Rupees Ten thousand. Three Naval cadets L. Abhishek Singh, Swapnil Baronia and Sharanya Khamparia visited Russia, Singapore and Sri Lanka respectively for the International Youth Exchange Programme (YEP). Cadet Vivek Rajput was selected for the International Naval Cruise and he visited Dubai, Yemen and Oman. Apart from students, NCC Officer Capt. Sonal Rai received the Chief Minister commendation and was awarded a cash prize of Rupees 50,000.

In order to train and prepare the youth for community services and contribute to their motherland, the College organizes various extension services through clubs and societies. Visit to Orphanage, Blind schools, Old age Homes, Prisons, Asha Kendra, Plantation, Anti-Tobacco Rally, Awareness programmes on AIDS, Cancer, Tobacco via Naukkad Natak, posters are part of the work ethos. We are happy to state that our students and teachers donated 183 units of blood. NSS Boys wing organized Seven days Unit camp at Parswara, Jabalpur and NSS Girls wing organized seven days Unit camp at Manegaon, Jabalpur.

The College through its Jabalpur Inter Religious Forum (JIRF) celebrates various festivals in collaboration with other institutes of the city, in order to promote solidarity, brotherhood, love and peace amongst religions. This year the College had arranged special classes on Karate to train girl students. Yoga and meditation classes for both boys and girls were also arranged. A workshop on disaster management was organized.

Various fests were held like Chem-Fest, Eco-Fest, Lit-Fest, Techno Zion, Bio-Fest and Zoo-Mania organized by department of Chemistry, Botany, English, Computer Science and Zoology of the College in order to channelize the talents of the students. This year the College again had the privilege of organizing Intercollegiate Classical and Non-Classical Singing competitions as part of the Youth Festival 2015-16.

The Annual Gold Medal and Certificate Distribution Ceremony was conducted on 13th April 2016. Justice K.K. Trivedi, Madhya Pradesh High court and an Ex-Aloysian was present as the Chief Guest, Most Rev. Gerald Almeida, Dr. Alka Nayak and Dr. K. L Jain, Additional Director, MP Higher Education as Special Guests On this ceremonious occasion thirty six gold medals and certificates were distributed to all the meritorious students.

The Annual Sports day was celebrated on the 20th December 2015 at St. Aloysius' College Ground. On the same day Inter B. Ed Sports meet was also organized, in which various B.Ed colleges from Jabalpur participated. The Annual Social Gathering was organized on the 23rd December 2016 with full gusto and enthusiasm. Students participated in various

dance, skit and music competitions. The Counseling, Career Guidance & Placement Cell had arranged 19 Campus Drives including thirteen Close campus and six Open placement drives. A total of 275 students have been selected in different companies.

I am happy to inform that new infrastructure has been added in the form of Central Research Centre established under FIST for Science subjects. In addition to this a Language Lab, staff toilets, students' toilets, and two classrooms have been added.

We are overwhelmed by the contributions of the esteemed members of Governing Body, Alumni, teachers, non-teaching staff and students. Their constant support helps us in achieving our visions. We sincerely believe that the College will grow from strength to greater strength.

Many milestones have been achieved, yet there are many dreams to be fulfilled, many plans and proposals still in the pipeline. We not only visualize and conceive of the very best for the institution, but we also believe that together with collective efforts, what the mind believes and conceives shall be achieved.
